UW>HELP

First, get your FSA ID.

- The process is quicker and easier when you have one.
- Visit studentaid.gov/fsaid to learn more.

Then, submit the FAFSA after October 1 at fafsa.gov or download a mail-in application.

- Each college you list on the FAFSA will send a financial aid offer to you, once you are admitted.
- Review and compare your offers.

FAFSA = FREE APPLICATION FOR FEDERAL STUDENT AID

Each UW has a preferred date by which it wants to receive your FAFSA. However, campuses continue to process applications throughout the year.

DID YOU KNOW?

Some colleges won't consider you for scholarships until you've submitted a FAFSA, so submit it even if you think you won't qualify for federal financial aid.
