## DID YOU KNOW?

Some colleges won't consider you for scholarships until you've submitted a FAFSA, so file it even if you think you won't qualify for federal financial aid.

Each UW has a recommended date by which it wants to receive your FAFSA. However, campuses continue to process applications throughout the year.

## TAKE ACTION TODAY WITH 3 EASY STEPS

- Set a reminder in your phone to complete the FAFSA before the recommended filing date on the reverse side.
- Take 5 minutes to create your Federal Student Aid ID at [fsaid.ed.gov](https://fsaid.ed.gov)
- Post this card on your wall or fridge.
