ADMISSIONS

UW-Eau Claire is still considering applications for new freshmen for fall 2019. Interested students should apply as soon as possible. Postponed applicants will hear from UW-Eau Claire no later than March 15.

ENROLLMENT + HOUSING

Admitted freshmen must submit their \$100 enrollment deposit and \$75 housing deposit (if applicable) by May 1 (refundable until May 1). Students should submit their \$100 enrollment deposit early, as Orientation information is sent only to students with submitted deposits beginning in mid-March.

Housing is guaranteed for all incoming students if the \$75 deposit and housing application are received by May 1st. Assignments are first-come, first-served.

Our Fall 2019 freshman Regular Decision application deadline is February 1. Applicants will receive a decision by March 31. Our transfer Priority Decision deadline is February 1. Applicants will hear by March 31. Our transfer Regular Decision deadline is March 1, and applicants will hear by April 30.

Our Fall 2018 class includes 6,862 freshmen—3,659 of which are Wisconsin residents—and 1,141 transfer students—659 from Wisconsin.

Freshmen can apply using either the UW System Application or the Common Application, and transfer students can apply through the UW System Application.

- **Distance Learning** – most courses are entirely online, and can be completed from anywhere; students save the time and cost of traveling to campus.
- **Accessible** – no application and no course seat caps.
- **Self-paced** – students set their own deadlines, track their own progress, and finish on their own timeline.
- **Transferable** – courses transfer to all UW campuses and many other colleges and universities.

ENROLLMENT INFORMATION

We are accepting Early College Credit Program (ECCP) registrations for the Spring 2019 semester. ECCP forms are due to our offices on or before December 24, 2018. Students will gain access to their course on January 7, 2019 and will have until May 3, 2019 to complete it, with options to extend upon approval.

High school students who are not eligible for ECCP or who wish to enroll on their own may register directly on our website any day of the year. Students will gain access to their course the business day their registration is processed and will have six months to complete it, with options to extend up to a year.
