What is 15 to Finish?

- Almost every 4-year degree requires 120 credits. For a 2-year degree, it's 60 credits.
- That means you'll need on average 15 credits per semester to graduate on time.


$$\frac{120 \text{ credits}}{4 \text{ years}} = 30 \text{ credits per year}$$

How can you take 15 to Finish?

You can split up 15 credits however you want. Just make sure it adds up to 30 credits for the entire year.

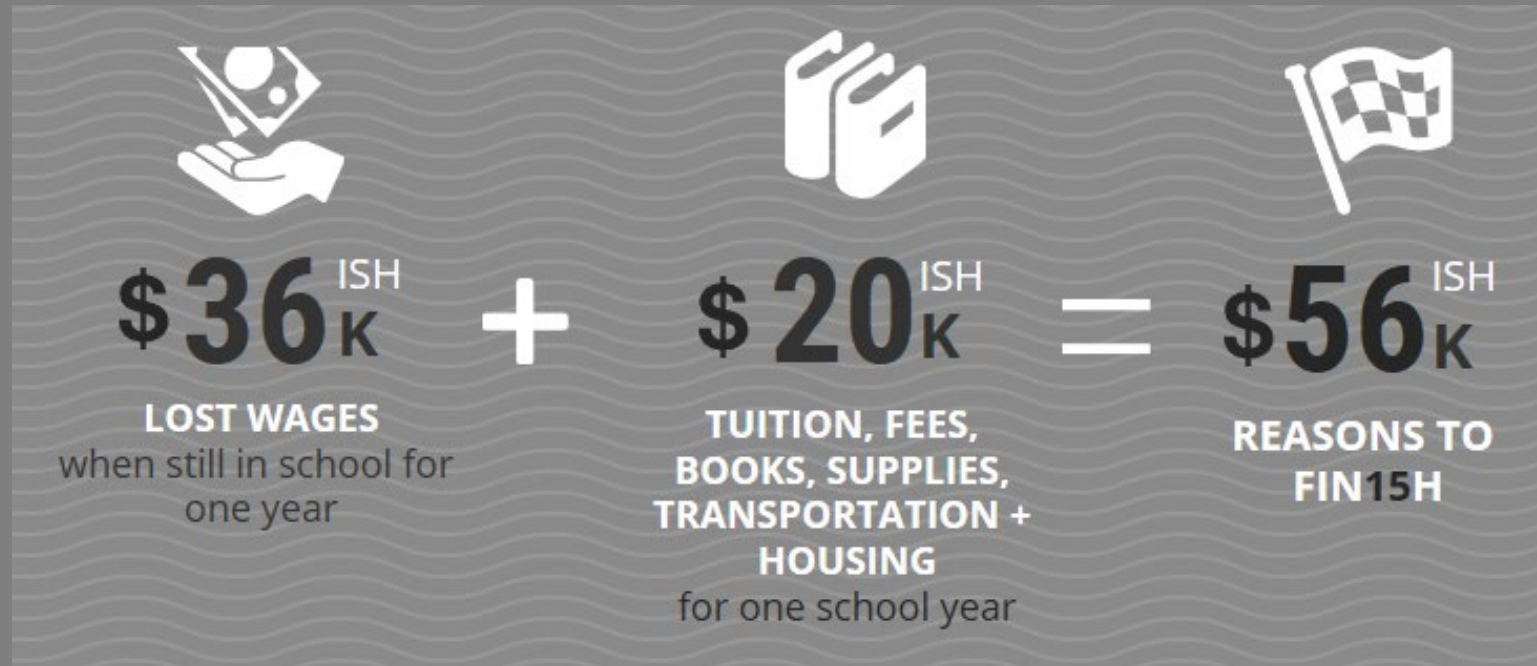

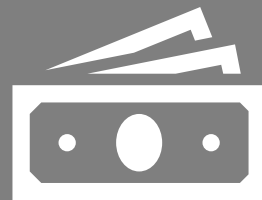

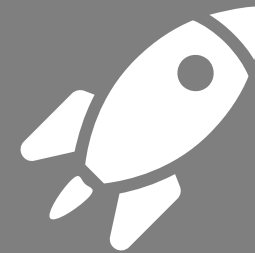
