To develop "college-ready" confidence, we are now offering a summer Bridge Program for select students. In the weeks before the fall semester, students can build a strong start through foundational credit-bearing courses and co-curricular activities.

UW-Green Bay is proud to provide all students with unique, challenging, and hands-on experiences, and we are proud to partner with you in your great work to assist students from all walks of life toward their higher-education goals.

NEW WAYS OF COLLEGE PREP

UW-Green Bay is offering students a jumpstart by providing multiple ways to earn college credits in high school. All programs are offered with reduced tuition rates—helping students save money while developing skills for college success.

- **Dual Enrollment Access Academy (The Academy):** Online courses scheduled on the high school calendar, offered only for high school students.
- **College Credit in High School (CCIHS):** Offered at 70 high schools across the state, CCIHS classes give students a taste of college in the familiar environment of their high school.
- **Early College Credit Program (ECCP):** Work with our dedicated high school student advisor to learn what classes will help students progress toward their future goals.
- **Rising Phoenix Early College High School Program:** Collaboration between school districts and UW-Green Bay providing students in the program with dual enrollment, ongoing student success coaching, and the opportunity to earn an Associate of Arts and Sciences degree alongside a high school diploma.


VISIT OPPORTUNITIES AROUND
