UW-Platteville is a leader in STEM education with cutting-edge facilities and unique labs, which includes Sesquicentennial Hall and the Huff Family Innovation Center. It is one of the largest makerspaces in the Midwest. The recently renovated Boebel Hall includes upgrades to the Cadaver Lab—a rare resource among undergraduate institutions—and TREES Lab. Our 400-acre Pioneer Farm includes unique facilities like the Forensic Investigation Crime Scene House.

Pioneer Promise

Pell-eligible, full-time first-year student at the Platteville campus, who have been admitted by May 1 and have completed their FAFSA by July 1, will have their on-campus tuition and some fees covered by the Pioneer Promise, with opportunities to renew annually.
